



PRIVACY POLICY

At I Can Have a Say Ltd (ICHAS) and Tracks4Change (T4C), we are committed to maintaining your privacy in accordance with the Data Protection Act 1998 (the Act). This Privacy Policy explains our commitment to data protection and how your personal information (e.g. your name, email address) (Information) may be used and stored. It should be read in conjunction with our websites' Terms of Use. Unless stated otherwise, all terms beginning with a capital letter shall have the meaning given to them in the websites' Terms of Use.

All your Information shall be used in accordance with the Act. ICHAS is the data controller of your Information for the purposes of the Act. Information collected through any on-site registration process or by means of any offline channel (e.g. by completing any consent forms associated with the T4C competition) may be used by ICHAS and carefully chosen third parties to contact you by various means, including but not limited to mail, telephone, SMS, MMS, fax or email:

- to send you information about ICHAS or the T4C competition;
- to alert you to changes to the terms and conditions of the T4C competition;
- to inform you of how the T4C competition is developing/changing, such as release and promotion of the finalists and overall winner; and
- for social impact monitoring purposes,

other than where you have indicated you do not wish to receive such information.

Disclosing your Information to third parties

We may disclose your Information to the following types of third parties:

- to Competition Suppliers or Partners for the purposes of running the competition only;
- in the event that we sell any business or assets we may disclose your Information to the potential buyer(s) of such business or assets (or their respective professional advisers); and

- if we are under a duty to disclose or share your Information to comply with any legal obligation or to enforce or apply our terms and conditions and other agreements or protect our rights or property, our customers, or others. This may include exchanging information with other companies and organisations for fraud protection and credit risk reduction.

You are entitled by law, upon the payment of a fee (£10), to receive a copy of the information and personal data held by ICHAS and to correct any inaccuracies in it. Any such requests must be made in writing to: Subject Access Requests, I Can Have a Say Ltd, at the address above.

We will take reasonable care to keep your Information secure and to prevent any unauthorised use of it. We may change this Privacy Policy from time to time and the change will take 30 days after the revised Privacy Policy is available on our homepages or if you continue to use and access our websites after such changes are posted on our websites' homepages (whichever is earlier). Please refer to this Privacy Policy each time you submit your personal Information.

Use of submitted user information by ICHAS

Information collected is used for the following purposes:

- general administration of the T4C competition;
- providing site access for you; and
- statistical analysis, market research and website use evaluation.
